

ADDENDUM-I

Item (7) (A), (B), (C), (D) & (E) of Notification No.01/JS(Per)/2017 , dated: 10.11.2017 shall be substituted with the following :

07: **Selection Procedure:**

A) The selection of candidate shall be based on the following criteria prescribed under weighted average selection Method.

a) Written test will be conducted for 100 Marks as detailed below;

Description	Syllabus	Marks
Section-A	On Core academic curriculum	50 Marks
Section-B	Computer awareness	20 Marks
Section-C	On analytical aptitude	15 Marks
Section-D	Language proficiency(Vocabulary, Sentence corrections, Reading comprehension)	15 Marks
Total		100 Marks

Should secure minimum 30 %marks **in each section** otherwise shall be treated as disqualified.

The minimum qualifying marks in the written test for the above selection process shall be for OC – 40%, BC- 35%, SC, ST and Physically challenged – 30%.

N.B. Mere securing minimum qualifying marks does not vest any right to a candidate for selection to the post of Trainee Junior Accounts Officer.

b) Total marks secured in written test are restricted to 80 Marks.

c) **Weightage Marks:**

(i) Weightage upto 10 marks will be given for passing of the following qualifying examinations up to the date of notification @ of 2 Marks for each completed year of passing. Fraction of months will be ignored. **(Provision for noting year of passing will be made available in the OMR Sheet)** i.e.,

B.Com First Class or its equivalent of any recognised university of India

First Class Post Graduate Degree of M.Com of any university in India established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, Provincial Act, or State Act or any equivalent qualification.
